

Knit Lamb

KTV2012K



Designed by Barbara Prime.

Lamb measures 8" tall.

NASHUA Handknits "Julia": 1 skein each 0010 Natural **A** and 4013 Aqua Fog **B**.

Knitting Needle: 4mm (US 6) Black embroidery thread. Polyester fiberfill.

Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 22 sts = 4"; 32 rows = 4". CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the specified gauge.

Legs (make 2)

With B, cast on 10 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Row 1: K1, (M1, k1) across - 19 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Row 3: K2, M1, k6, M1, k3, M1, k6, M1, k2 – 23 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Cut **B** and join **A**.

With A, work 2 rows in St st.

Row 7: K7, (skp) twice, (k2tog) twice, k8 - 19 sts.

Row 8: P6, (p2tog) twice, (p2tog tbl) twice, p5 - 15 sts.

Row 9: K6, k2tog, k7 – 14 sts.

Work 3 rows in St st.

Row 13: K1, M1, k12, M1, k1 - 16 sts.

Work 9 rows in St st.

Row 23: K1, (k2tog) 7 times, k1 - 9 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Row 25: K1, (k2tog) 4 times – 5 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread end through remaining stitches, pull tight to close and knot to secure.

Body

With **A** and beginning at neck edge, cast on 15 stitches.

Purl 1 row.

Row 1: K1 (M1, k1) across – 29 sts.

Work 5 rows in St st.

Row 7: (K7, M1) twice, k1, (M1, k7) twice – 33 sts.

Work 5 rows in St st.

Row 13: K15, M1, k3, M1, k15 – 35 sts.

Work 3 rows in st st.

Row 17: K3, M1, k1, M1, k27, M1, k1, M1, k3 – 39 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Row 19: K16, skp, k3, k2tog, k16 – 37 sts.

Work 3 rows in St st.

Row 23: K15, skp, k3, k2tog, k15 – 35 sts.

Work 3 rows in St st.

Row 27: K1, (k2tog) 17 times - 18 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Row 29: (K2tog) across - 9 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread end through remaining stitches, pull tight to close and knot to secure.

Right Arm

With B, cast on 6 stitches.

Purl 1 row.

Row 1: K1, (M1, k1) across – 11 sts.

⊃url 1 row.

Row 3: (K2, M1) twice, k3, (M1, k2) twice – 15 sts.


Purl 1 row.

Cut **B** and join **A**.

With **A**, work 2 rows in St st.

Row 7: K1, (skp) twice, (k2tog) twice, k6 - 11 sts.

Work 3 rows in St st.



Row 11: K1, M1, k9, M1, k1 - 13 sts.

Work 9 rows in St st.

Row 21: K1, (k2tog) 6 times – 7 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Row 23: K1, (k2tog, k1) twice – 5 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread end through remaining stitches, pull tight to close and knot to secure.

Left Arm

With B, cast on 6 stitches.

Purl 1 row.

Row 1: K1, (M1, k1) across - 11 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Row 3: (K2, M1) twice, k3, (M1, k2) twice – 15 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Cut B and join A.

With A, work 2 rows in St st.

Row 7: K6, (skp) twice, (k2tog) twice, k1 - 11 sts.

Continue to work as for Right Arm.

Head

With A, cast on 7 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Row 1: K1, (M1, k1) across – 13 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Row 3: K1, (M1, k1) across - 25 sts.

Work 3 rows in St st.

Row 7: K1, (M1, k3) across - 33 sts.

Work 10 rows in St st.

Cut A and join B.

Row 26: With B, purl 1 row.

Row 27: K12, k2tog, k5, skp, k12 – 31 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Row 29: (K2tog) 7 times, k3, (skp) 7 times – 17 sts.

Work 3 rows in St st.

Row 33: K1, (k2tog) across – 9 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread end through remaining stitches, pull tight to close and knot to secure.

Ears (make 2)

With A, cast on 4 sts.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: K1, M1, k to last st, M1, k1.

Repeat last 2 rows once more – 10 sts.

Work in garter stitch for 8 rows.

Bind off.

Tail

With A, cast on 8 sts.

Beginning with a wrong side row, work 5 rows in St st.

Next Row: (K2tog) 4 times – 4 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread end through remaining stitches, pull tight to close and knot to secure.

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Finishing

Embroider face on Head with straight stitches. Stuff Head tightly with fiberfill, adding extra fiberfill in nose and sew closed. Fold bound-off edge of each Ear in half and sew together. Sew bound-off edge of each Ear on either side of Head. Sew up back seam of Body to neck edge, leaving neck edge open. Stuff tightly. Sew Head securely to open neck edge of Body.

Sew seam of each Arm, leaving an opening. Stuff tightly and sew closed. Thread a length of yarn through Left Arm about 1/4" from top edge, pull yarn through Body at shoulder position, then thread yarn though Right Arm. Pull yarn through Body again, and then through Left Arm, pulling tightly. Repeat several times so Arms are in place securely.

Sew sole and back Leg seams, leaving an opening for stuffing. Stuff tightly with fiberfill and sew closed. Attach Legs at lower edge of Body in same manner as Arms. Sew tail in place.

Weave in ends.



NASHUA Handknits "Julia",

13/4 oz (50g), 93 yd (85m) skeins.

ABBREVIATIONS: A = Color A; **B** = Color B; **K** = knit; **K2tog** = knit next 2 sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **P** = Purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **Skp** = Slip next st, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped st over; **St st** = Stockinette stitch; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS:

M1 (make 1 stitch) = pick up horizontal strand of yarn lying between stitch just worked and next st, knit this st.
